

**Live Workshop:**  
**Shibori-Style Fabric Dying**

Supply List

Cotton kitchen string or strong rubber bands for tying bundles  
Rubber bands for wrapping fabric, small or medium sizes  
Pairs of wooden shapes for resist dyeing- Can be pieces of ¼" thick slats usually no bigger than 2 x 2"

Popsicle sticks, chop sticks, flat wooden knick-knacks, pairs of wood or plexiglass shapes up to ½" thick plastic clothes pins, metal paper clamps in medium or large sizes. All for attaching to fabric to go into the dye bath. No items can be used again for food or regular handling.

3 yards 100% cotton fabric, a variety such as Kona, bleached muslin, broadcloth, is welcome

Optional: Up to 1 yard of silk fabric

18" piece of cotton rope/clothesline

Bonded Nylon thread, if stitching: order from MAIWA or JoAnn Fabrics online, brown/black better than white

Scissors

PVC pipe in 3-4 ft. length

Thin strong string (poly or cotton) for wrapping

Embroidery Needles both long and short, large eye helps

Comfortable work gloves

Apron or work clothes. Dye will not come out of clothing.

Portable drying rack if you have one available
